

Cthulhu

Assembly Instructions

Note: Special tools are required to build this model, which may not be suitable for children.

Tools you will need: Scissors or (preferably) a craft knife, cutting mat, ruler, PVA glue.

- Print out all four pages of the Cthulhu model on your desk top printer. For best results use a high-quality standard weight paper.

- Trim the sheets along the black line on all four sides (this will help you align the front of the sheets to the backs).

- Glue Page 1 to Page 2, Page 3 to Page 4 using a spray adhesive.

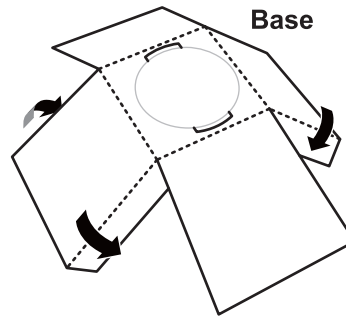
- Cut to the *inside* of the black edges of each part.

- Make folds by *gently* dragging the tip of your scissors (or knife) along the dashed lines.

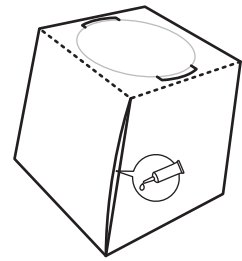
Practice this method on a piece of scrap paper to get the right feel.

- Make a few glue spreaders out of card scraps measuring about 10 x 50 mm. These help to apply glue evenly.

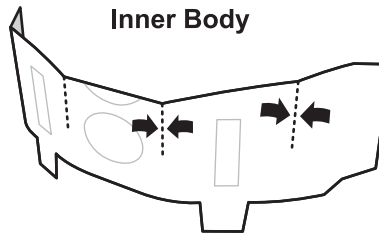
- Take your time. Cthulhu is *patient*.



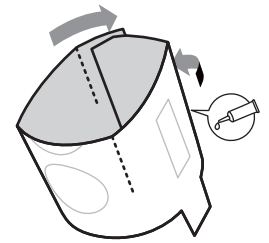
1a Fold down all four white glue flaps, then fold down sides of **Base**.



1b Glue flaps to the inside of **Base**.



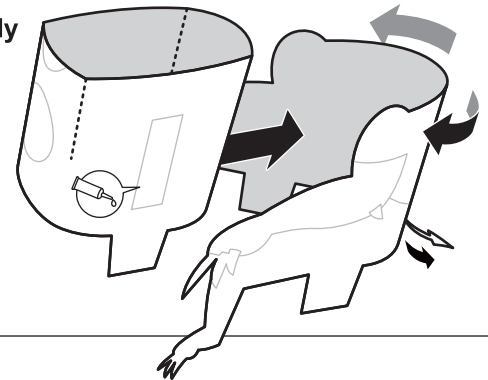
2a Fold **Inner Body** at fold lines to make corners.



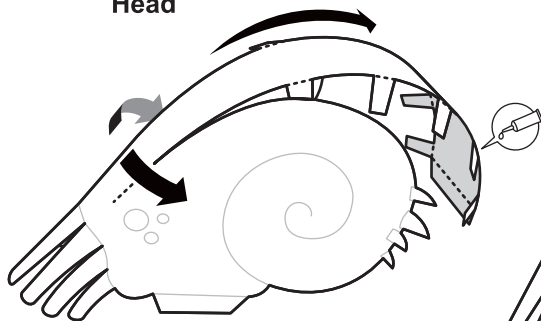
2b Fold **Inner Body** into a tube and glue.

Outside Body

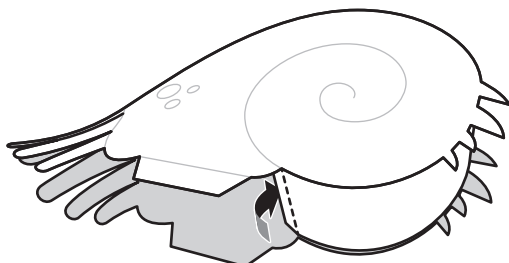
2c Wrap **Outer Body** around **Inner Body** and glue both sides. Curl Tail up slightly.



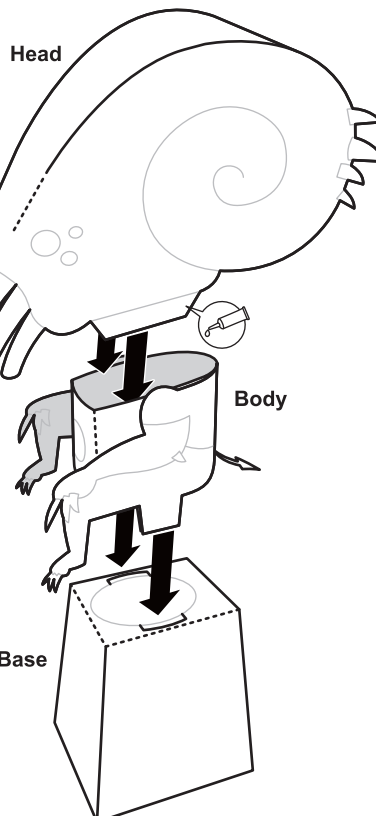
Head



3a Fold back both sides of **Head**. Curl center strip and fold in all ten small glue flaps.

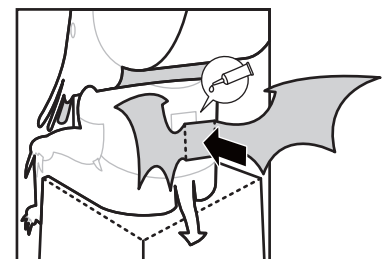


3b Glue all small glue flaps to the inside of **Head**, then fold in the end flap.



4 Glue both side flaps on **Head** to the inside of **Body**. Insert both side tabs of **Body** into curved slots on top of **Base**.

Wings



5 Fold back both **Wings**. Glue center to white square on back of **Body**.
